Thank you for choosing Blue Power Cold Air intake.

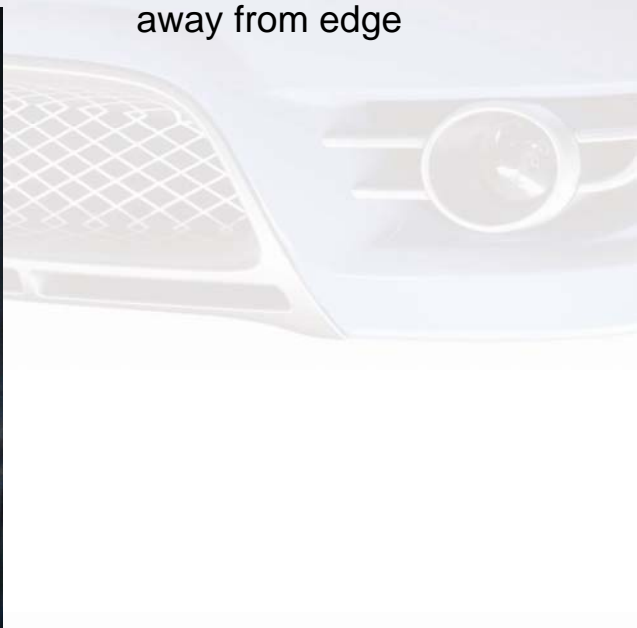
You are fitting the a record breaking CAI to your car that has been proven on the drag Strip with records in Fastest 3 Valve, N/A 6, Boss 260/290/302/315 and Blown 260/290 and these records still stand...



Remove Old Airbox and Piping to cross over cover



Bend Air Cond pipe away from edge

Remove the wiring plug that's next to the washerbottle and just let it hang

down out of the way.

Sit the air box panel in place using the lid to get a nice snug fit then mark with a texta, remove lid and drill holes to put panel in place. Use screws supplied, there's a bracket up the front near the headlight, I don't attach this it's your choice.

Now the ribbed intake hose that you removed earlier, place a small amount of grease/lube on the inside edge on the hose and slide 6Cyl adaptor into the hose. This may be tight and warming the hose will make it easier.



Slide supplied filter through hole in side panel and connect up to 6Cyl Adaptor
